On Monday, August 22nd guest speaker Jocelin Padilla from the [Port of Long Beach](#) and her colleague Dora Cortes presented to the EALB. They shared a great powerpoint of the Port's operations, statistics, history and more to the Executives Association of Long Beach during our weekly networking luncheon. They also informed members on how they can register with the port to be informed of bids and how to submit estimates. Interestingly enough, the Port does have a goal of sending a percentage of bids to certified small businesses.

As residents and business owners in Long Beach the Port is something we can all be proud of. Together with the Port of LA they make up the 10th largest port in the world. Shanghai is the largest and Singapore is the second largest port in the world.

Interesting facts about the Port of Long Beach:

1 in 8 employees in Long Beach works for the Port.

Top exports include petroleum coke, coal and minerals.

They recently purchased one of the best fire boats in the world. It is the most technologically advanced fire boats and serves as it's own command center.

Middle Harbor renovations are halfway done and will increase the capacity of the Port by 20-30%. The new cranes will be able to lift two containers at once, it will be an entirely electric green port and can support 20 teu ships.

The new bridge to replace the Gerald Desmond bridge will be finished in 2018. It will have emergency lanes, viewing platforms, bike lanes and more to make it better for the community. It will also be significantly higher to accommodate the larger ships needing to pass beneath it.

The Port of Long Beach is dedicated to becoming a zero emissions port. They are spending hefty sums on infrastructure and sustainable energy. They are one of a few ports

in the world to have shore power available. It's expensive for ships to upgrade to using shore power but the Port offers incentives to shippers who invest in cleaner ships.

The next big thing for the Port is what they are calling Energy Island. it's a concept, not an island but it would essentially mean they would use renewable energy (either wind, wave or solar) to have their own power and be completely off the city's grid for electricity. In the event of major power outages in Long Beach like we saw last year in downtown, the Port would be able to offer their power to the city. Sounds like an interesting concept to me.
